#### Year 2

## **Mathematics**

In maths we will be following the Power Maths and White Rose schemes of learning.

Our focus in maths will be length, height, mass and capacity. We will also look at telling the time.

# English

In our writing we will be reading the story 'Field trip to the moon' and using this to inspire our writing. We will be learning the features of setting descriptions and how to use exclamation marks, coordinating and subordinating conjunction. We will then start our non– fiction learning on writing instructions based on the book 'curiosity story rover' and learn how to use apostrophes.

## How can you support your child?

Ensure your child is accessing spelling shed weekly. New spellings are added every Friday.

## Wider Curriculum

In History, we will be learning about significant individuals who played a part in space explorations including Neil Armstrong, Tim Peake and Katherine Johnson.

In Science, we will be looking at everyday materials (chemistry). We will learn to identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials. We will also investigate the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed.

In RE, we will be learning about Hinduism. We will about where Hindu's worship, key Hindu celebrations and key practices that Hindu's carry out.

In Computing, we will be consolidating our learning from earlier in the year, by logging onto a computer using a username and password. We will learn to explore the effects of sound and music in animation and video. We will also explore Microsoft Word using different features of the program.
